**RAEE, ROHS, REACH
STATEMENT**

20/11/2023

We hereby declare that our items do not fall within the scope of Directive 2012/19/EU known as WEEE or Directive 2011/65/EU known as ROHS, as they do not include electrical components.

We hereby also state that our items are fully compliant with the requirements of the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH):

1. According to the structure of the REACH regulation, our company is a manufacturer of "ITEMS" for our customers based in the EU.
We do not manufacture "substances" or "preparations" and our items do not involve the intentional release of substances during foreseeable use.
No registration or pre-registration or authorization is required for the product we supply.
2. With reference to the requirements of Article 33 of REACH: "Obligation to disclose information on substances contained in items", **we declare that none of the SVHC** (Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorization published in accordance with Article 59 of REACH regulation) **is present in our item in a concentration equal to or greater than 0,1% weight/weight**
3. Regarding the requirements of Article 67 of REACH: A substance as such, in a preparation or in an item, **listed in Annex XVII**, subject to use restrictions must not be placed on the European market or used unless it complies with the conditions of that restriction. We state that **none of the restricted use substances are present in our product**.

We also inform you that our company is not directly involved in what the regulation provides, as regards the registration procedure of chemical compounds as **it does not manufacture substances or preparations but it's only a user**, and that they are purchased by companies that have ensured compliance with Regulation 1907/2006.

The Company has therefore made every effort to fulfil its obligations, namely:

- check with its suppliers whether the items supplied contain SVHC substances from the "candidate list" above the legal threshold (0,1% w/w).
- check with its suppliers that all substances as such or present in mixtures subject to REACH have been registered by them (or by upstream subjects) or pre-registered according to REACH.
- check that the substances used in the manufacture of its products are used within the conditions of use provided for such substances as such or contained in mixtures.
- in the event of a supplier failing to comply with one of the sections above, find valid alternatives compliant with REACH in order to guarantee continuity of supplies.
- based on the information received, evaluate any presence of SVHC substances in the products supplied to the customer

As the REACH regulation is updated frequently, for subsequent major changes, such as the inclusion of **SVHC substances in Annex XIV**, the inclusion of restricted substances in Annex XVII, our Company will evaluate further revisions over time and will update the statement to reflect these changes.

In the event of **failure to submit a new Declaration**, the validity of what is shown in this document is deemed to be valid.
